Arlington Public Library launches a new book collection, “Grab & Go,” which grants library patrons quick access to the most popular books and eBooks without having to wait. The express collection contains both bestselling adult fiction and nonfiction titles such as:

- “The Nickel Boys” by Colson Whitehead
- “Where the Crawdads Sing” by Delia Owens
- “Fleishman is in Trouble” by Taffy Brodesser-Akner
- “The Pioneers” by David McCullough

“We want our patrons to have access to the books they want, when they want them,” said Library Director Diane Kresh “Visit any branch and get them while they are hot.”

Visitors to all library branches will discover popular Grab & Go titles, ready to be checked out immediately, and digital readers will receive instant access to favorite eAudiobooks and eBook titles from Overdrive. The Grab & Go collection will not display in the library catalog, which makes this an exclusive treat to Arlington residents and library patrons. Titles can be checked out for two weeks and no holds can be placed.
