**Submit your entry between July 22 and August 18, 2024 to any library location or online. Free and open to all!**

*Use the boxed area to create your artwork.  
Your artwork can be horizontal or vertical.*

- Artwork should relate to the freedom to read, books and the library.
- You may use any material including colored pencils or crayons to create your artwork or design in the rectangle to the right. Digital entries (JPEG, TIF, PNG AI, PDF, EPS) are accepted up to 10 MB per entry. The size for digital entries is 7.125x3 inches.
- Entries must be submitted online or in-person at any library location by Sunday, August 18.
- Winners will be chosen in five categories: pre-K, elementary school, middle school, high school and adults.
- Winners will be notified by early September and may pick up copies of their printed bookmark to share starting Sept. 22.
- One entry per person.
- Art becomes the property of Arlington Public Library, will not be returned and may be used for future library promotional materials.

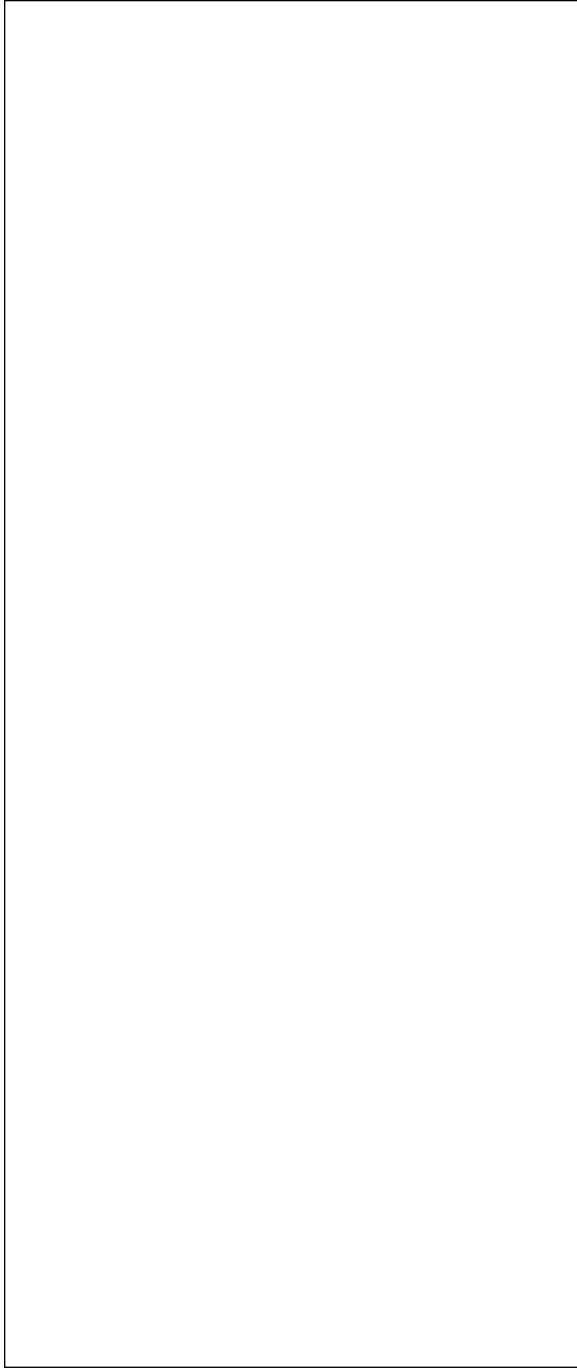
